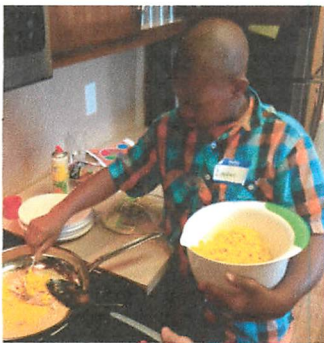




“Our House,”

and clean (great life skills).

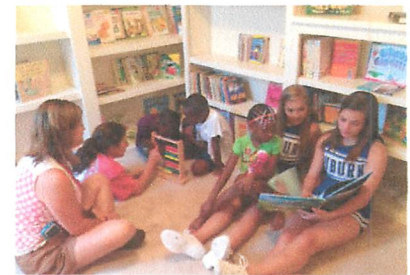
Each Saturday morning this summer, we
