We also appreciate the Tailgate Guys for donating tables to us this summer. We use them often and especially appreciate your generous gift when feeding a crowd.

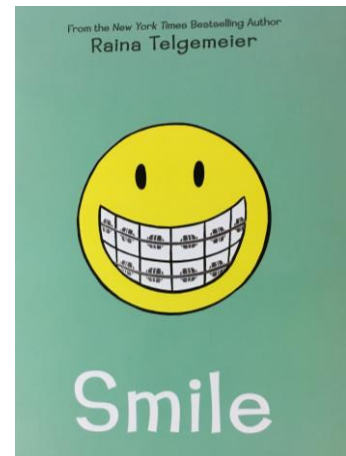
